Buxted Parish Council use a method of fixed asset valuation for first registration on the asset register from acquisition cost. This means that in most circumstances once recorded in the asset register, the recorded value of the asset will not change from year to year until disposal. Commercial concepts of depreciation, impairment adjustments, and revaluation are not required or appropriate for this method of asset valuation.

The purchase of the defibrillator and cabinet have been completed through a Managed Solution programme. The defibrillator and cabinet belong to Community HeartBeat Trust for 4 years, the parish council then can purchase it for £1. Community HeartBeat deal with the insurance of the items for the 4 years.
